COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Using a GPS unit, discover the natural treasures of Hidden Valley in Rocky Mountain National Park. Follow the clues left in nature to uncover the hidden mysteries that are in this subalpine ecosystem. This class is designed for kids who want to spend time in Rocky Mountain National Park learning about nature while enjoying the adventure and fun of practicing a new skill.

Note: This class is recommended for first-time geocachers.

COURSE LEVEL II:

Short-distance walks throughout the day primarily on level terrain with some stops located off-trail.
