#### LOCATION: MORAINE PARK DISCOVERY CENTER

Take Hwy. 36 toward the south entrance of Rocky Mountain National Park. Turn left on Bear Lake Road after the Beaver Meadows entrance station. Follow the road until you see a sign on your left reading "Moraine Park Discovery Center." Turn left into the parking lot, and meet the instructor outside the entrance to the building.

# **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

Thunderstorms? Bears? Trails that lead to nowhere? Learn to prepare for whatever nature throws your way! In this course kids will learn the basics of outdoor survival from what to pack for a hike to how to survive a night alone in the wilderness. Participants will also learn to make a fire and build a shelter using materials found outdoors.

#### **COURSE LEVEL: II**

Short-distance walks throughout the day primarily on level terrain.

# **REFUND POLICY:**
