LOCATION: Lily Lake – Take Hwy. 7 heading south out of Estes Park. Approximately five miles out of town and across from the Twin Sisters Trailhead is Lily Lake. Meet the instructor by the restrooms near the parking lot on the west side of the road.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: While bugs are often seen as annoying and gross, they are actually quite extraordinary! They can lift impressive amounts, fly far distances, and jump to astonishing heights. Learn the basics of our little bug friends through art and exploration as we capture bugs with nets, study them with magnifying glasses, and even create our own to take home. Learn what bugs are and what they need to live. It may shock you to discover what our tiniest of neighbors are capable of!

COURSE LEVEL: II

Short-distance walks throughout the day primarily on level terrain.

10:05 AM – Introduction to insects and arachnids (aka: bugs)

10:15 AM – Build a Bug: What better way to learn about the parts of a bug than by creating your own!

10:45 AM – Catch bugs

11:15 AM – Learn what jobs our bugs do

Note: Rocky Mountain Conservancy-Field Institute recommends that participants for all courses dress in layers and wear comfortable, sturdy hiking boots/shoes. Participants should be prepared for sudden changes in temperature and weather conditions.

REFUND POLICY:
